1. Call to Order:

The Public Safety Committee meeting was called to order by Alderperson Cummings at 6:00PM

2. Roll Call:

5. Unfinished Business:

- a.) **Recreational Vehicles Ordinance 261-6** – Alderperson Cummings stated that she would like to remove "Food Trucks" from Recreational Vehicles Ordinance 261-6 and create a separate ordinance specifically governing food trucks.
- b.) The proposed ordinance would require food truck operators to obtain a permit from the City and would address seasonal operations, prohibit full-time parking of food trucks outside the owner's residence, prohibit sales from a residential location, and establish restrictions regarding vehicle size, permitted locations, and other operational requirements.
- c.) The committee will continue working on the ordinance language and provisions before scheduling an open meeting for further discussion.
